- Providing assistance in program planning, special project planning and implementation.

- Providing assistance and support of SMART implementation within other BSMART programs - including possible on site mentoring.
- Organizing and conducting camps as a lead instructor inclusive of registration, preparation, planning and overseeing the entire process.
- Moving, organising of equipment and assisting with packing away materials and cleaning when necessary.

The successful candidate will have:

- Bachelor's degree in elementary education; preferably special education or early childhood education.
- Minimum of five years teaching experience.
