Responsibilities include:

- Provide analysis, modeling, pricing and underwriting recommendations for assumed transactions, applicable to the Credit & Financial Lines team. These lines of business primarily include: mortgage, structured credit, political risk, trade credit, surety and title.
- Be an integral part of the underwriting process, from initial broker contact to providing underwriting recommendations on transactions to servicing client requests after the transaction closes
- Use third party vendor models, proprietary tools and risk systems to effectively extract, analyze and report for deal and portfolio analyses; interpret and challenge model results
- Recommend and implement model developments and changes where needed
- Proactively research and explore new business opportunities and client/broker relationships
- In support of aggregate management analyses, use proprietary exposure management tools to capture reported exposures on bound transactions.
- Investigate, evaluate and advise on new risk models, changes to current risk models, and implement new models when necessary
- Contribute to the design and development of proprietary tools that will enable improved analyses, reporting, manipulation of data and workflow
- Responsibility for internal model and tool development projects, liaising with the underwriting and development teams to ensure that the tools address business requirements
- Responsible for developing and managing relationships with brokers, and clients through regular interactions and meetings
- Management, training, mentoring and development of analysts
