Responsibilities include:

- Working with the SVP Corporate Actuary to
- Update the quarterly reserves, working closely with Finance, Underwriting and Claims teams
 - Analyse reserving results and respond to questions both internally and externally from the external actuaries and auditors
 - Actively support the Reserving Function by conducting reserving assumptions reviews, improving reserving methodologies, enhancing reserving tools and improving all related processes
 - Provide reserving information for reporting requirements both internally and externally
 - Support the calculation of the Solvency II Technical Provisions and update assumptions as required and in line with guidance updates
 - Assist with the preparation of reserving inputs during the business planning process
 - Contribute to the ongoing development of the capital model in particular regarding the reserve risk and risk margin
 - Support as needed other aspects of the Risk Function such as Swiss Solvency Test and Bermuda's Commercial Insurers' Solvency Self-Assessment (CISSA) and Bermuda Solvency Capital Requirement (BSCR)
 - Complete ad hoc assignments, as needed
