Network - Systems Administrator

Reporting to the Information Technology Systems Manager, the Network – Systems Administrator will develop and implement integrated systems for optimal performance, considering both the hardware and software elements, their interrelationship and compatibility. He or she is required to have extensive knowledge of different technologies from both a hardware and software perspective. The Network-Systems Administrator must also have an understating of the user requirements and related solutions and practices, to ensure all needs are met and optimal performance is achieved.

Key Responsibilities include:

- Alongside the Information Technology Systems Manager proactively resolve complex systems issues.
- Assist with the installation, configuration and testing of complex systems, ensuring all technical and functional specification are met.
- Provide setup and support of network and communication systems, including, but not limited to, Local Area Network (LAN) systems, Wide Area Network (WAN) systems, telephone systems, VPN, VLANs, switches/routers and wireless technologies.
- Ensure security management and reporting including but not limited to firewall, encryption and user management.
- Along with the Information Technology Systems Manager provide setup and support of network operating systems that include but not limited to: Servers, NAS, VMWare, Windows Servers, File and Print services, Active Directory (Domain Servers/Services, Azure AD Sync, Federation services), Exchange or Office 365 Business systems, Disaster recovery, Backups and recovery.
- Provide support to network related technologies including but not limited to DHCP, DNS, SMTP, HTTP.
- Ensure all systems are up to date with patches and updates.
- Work with other members of the team and provide coverage as required.
- Provide and maintain documentation of all aspects of tasks and projects.
- Augment end user support as needed.
- Resolve incidents and service requests within a timely manner which include, logging tickets and documentation of issues.
- Remove and relocate equipment as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Minimum of a Bachelor's degree or equivalent, with a focus in Computer Science, Engineering or a related field.
- Minimum of 5 years in a similar position as a systems/network administrator or in systems engineering.
