

CARPENTER

We require a mature and reliable person with proven experience in Carpentry. The successful candidate will be responsible for performing preventative maintenance on guestrooms, public areas or equipment or as assigned.

Responsibilities will include:

- Inspects ceilings, floors, wall coverings or other woodwork to detect broken or damaged structures and constructs, repairs, restores and
- Fits and installs structures such as floors, doors, door frames, door hardware, window frames, cabinets, shelves, roofs and interior/exterior trim using a carpenter's level, plumb bob, and laser levels
- Studying specifications in building or design plans to determine dimensions and materials required and shapes or cuts materials to specified measurements, using hand tools, machines, or power saws
- Follows established safety rules and regulations and maintains a safe and clean environment
- Assembles and fastens materials to make frameworks or props, using hand tools and wood screws, nails, dowel pins, or glue
- Removes damaged or defective parts or sections of structures and repairs or replaces, using hand tools
- Installs locks, knobs, hinges, closures, and other fixtures to structures.
- Repairs and maintains doors, floors, windows, partitions, ceilings, furniture and exteriors of buildings; builds and installs door and window framing.
- Builds wooden structures such as partitions, building, office additions, fences, and scaffolds and does sheeting and rough carpentry on the buildings
- Performs hand and bench work in carpentry work shop; operates planers, joiners, drill presses, power saws, sanders, and other woodworking machinery
- Assists with painting if required
- Fulfils other responsibilities as assigned by management

- High school diploma or equivalent and a carpentry certification or diploma from a recognized Vocational Training School
- Minimum five (5) years' commercial carpentry experience
- Ability to comprehend schematic diagrams and other specifications provided
