- Leads stroke community efforts on behalf of BHB in conjunction with Stroke Medical Director

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited School of Nursing (BSN)
- Master's degree in an affiliated health related field preferred
- Project Management (CAPM) designation from an approved Institute and demonstrable application an asset
- National Institute of Health (NIH) Stroke Certification
- Three – five (3-5) years of Registered Nurse experience with neurology stroke patients (ideally within critical care setting)
- Current licensure and registration as required by the Bermuda Nurses Council and Allied Health Council
