- Able to plan and deliver a full range of age-relevant subjects, following the Cambridge curriculum and GCSE syllabus and incorporating IB teaching

Must be capable of designing an individualized plan to present the British curriculum in a way that will support those with anxiety and dyslexia and executive functioning difficulties

- Develops lesson plans and instructional material to adapt the curriculum to the needs of the child
- Translates lesson plans into developmentally appropriate learning experiences
- Proven experience supporting young children with emotional concerns (anxiety, stress management, etc.) and assist them in developing appropriate social skills
- A passion for teaching, especially children with reading disorders
- Ability to speak and teach Spanish preferred
- Ability and patience to work interactively
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Strong computer skills to implement multiple and diverse programs
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to effectively interpret student data such as diagnostic test results and assessments scoring
