The successful applicant will be a self-starter with a strong sense of accountability and ownership of work assigned. They must be able to deliver results under tight deadlines with minimal supervision. Given the nature of our work, it will be necessary to work outside ordinary business hours from time to time.

Leadership Responsibilities

- Monitor casualty claims handling processes and make recommendations for changes to increase efficiencies and productivity;
- Provide training and mentorship to other team members;
- Coordinate regular claims update meetings with claims handlers and underwriters;
- Assist the Head of Bermuda Claims with ad-hoc management-related projects to support transition within the claims team and wider company.

Claims Handling Responsibilities

- Serve as subject matter expert for casualty claims;
- Effectively manage a diverse book of complex and significant claims;
- Establish a process for efficient and effective handling of low exposure claims;
- Carry out, document and communicate liability, coverage and exposure reviews; Represent the company's interests at claims meetings,
- mediations, and arbitration hearings, both locally and overseas;
- Establish expense and indemnity reserves within the authority established by the Head of Bermuda Claims and maintain necessary documentation to support those reserves: Develop and execute claims handling and litigation plans;
- Track and control claim-related expenses;
- Complete ad-hoc claims-related projects as required.

Review and draft bespoke policy forms and endorsements;

- Provide analysis and guidance on liability trends and issues affecting exposure;
- Attend underwriting meetings;
- Provide pre-underwriting intelligence on specific risks.
