## TEACHING POSITIONS FOR JANUARY 2020

### **Teacher of Girls Physical Education**

### **Teacher of IB, I/GCSE & KS3 French and Spanish**

An experienced Secondary teacher with at least 3 years' appropriate experience is required to teach French and Spanish to both Higher and Standard Levels of the International Baccalaureate, IGCSE/GCSE and the UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3. Successful applicants must hold a relevant languages degree and a Secondary teaching qualification, and meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teacher's License.

Applicants must be able to show experience in the educational programmes offered at Warwick Academy (UK National Curriculum, IGCSE/GCSE, and International Baccalaureate) or similar curricula (A-level/AP) and be able to relate positively to students, staff and parents. Proven success at external examinations is essential. In addition, they must be willing to contribute to the extensive co-curricular and pastoral programmes at the school.
