Responsibilities

- Work with Customer Solutions Engineers to ensure technical specifications and solutions are implemented as per the Approved Engineering Request and Design;
- Conduct Project Management of Customer implementation Solutions to ensure smooth and timely customer cutover.
- Process multiple ongoing customer(s) implementations;
- Work with installation and operations to ensure solutions are delivered on time and provide the necessary information and equipment for ongoing support;
- Work with partner teams such as outside plant build, equipment installation and operations support to the engineering design
- Deliver a plant ready solution to Business Support, where applicable, to coordinate customer installation of Business Services.
- Interface with suppliers to ensure equipment is ordered and delivered on time;
- Provide Sales and the customer with ongoing updates, on project status;
- Evaluate the quality of technical installations to ensure standards were followed according to the approved design;
- Primary point of contact for investigating customer complaints that arise during or after implementation;
- Responsible for reviewing the work of the technicians and determining whether there are any deficiencies with that work;
- Provide recommendations to improve the implementation process including the technical quality of installations
- Create and maintain customer reporting for circuits – data and voice.
