Bermuda Cancer and Health Centre is a registered charity engaged in the prevention, detection and support of cancer and other health concerns in the local community. The facility provides both diagnostic imaging and radiation therapy services. Bermuda Cancer and Health Centre has a state-of-the-art, purpose-built, Radiation Therapy Unit, staffed by a highly qualified and experienced radiation team.

We are seeking an enthusiastic Radiation Oncologist or Clinical Oncologist to assist the Radiation Oncology Medical Director in providing excellent comprehensive care that is compassionate, appropriate and effective for the consultation, planning, treatment management, and follow up care for each patient. - Demonstrate an investigatory and analytic approach to clinical situations
