

TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES AT BHS

BHS, an International Baccalaureate School based in Bermuda, is an all-girls school from the Early Years Programme to Year 11 and offers an IB co-ed programme in Years 12 and 13 (IB1 & IB2). The School offers the International Primary Curriculum, the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the (I)GCSE curriculum in Years 10 and 11, and the IB Diploma and Courses in the final two years of the School. Students may also sit the SAT examinations in IB1/IB2.

At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, STEAM, community service and leadership development. BHS promotes a student-centred approach to pedagogy and learning.

We are currently seeking the following for September 2020:

Teacher of Computer Science, Information Technology & Design Technology and Head of Information Technology (IT) Department

This position requires the teaching of Computer Science and some Information Technology from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels. In addition, the applicant will be required to teach some aspects of Design Technology and work to incorporate STEAM throughout the School. Potentially, this role includes the Head of Department position, so it would be beneficial if the candidate has prior experience in leading a department and subject across a school.

Teacher of History, English, Humanities & Theory of Knowledge and Theory of Knowledge Co-ordinator

This position requires the teaching of History, English and Humanities from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels. The successful candidate will be required to teach IB Theory of Knowledge (TOK) and as the Theory of Knowledge Coordinator, will also be required to work with Heads of Departments to develop strategies for teaching TOK across all IB subjects, as well as monitor student progress.

All applicants for the above positions should hold strong academic qualifications: a Bachelor's degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject would be a requirement for these vacancies. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should also be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.

All applicants are asked to provide the following information: Post applied for, full name, date of birth and nationality, full details of Secondary and Higher Education with dates, full qualifications with dates, full details of teaching and other experience and **three** written professional references with their contact information. One of these references should be from a supervisor at the current place of employment. The successful candidate will be expected to provide a recent Police background check and complete SCARS training in order to demonstrate that they may work in an organisation involving children.
