He/She must hold a minimum of a College Degree or Diploma in Music. Must be able to play contemporary and southern style gospel, praise and worship, anthems, and a variety of other styles often incorporated into our services on the piano, keyboard, and organ at a high level of proficiency. He/She will be responsible for preparing and organizing all other musicians for services and be able to effectively lead the church in worship.

He/She must be able to direct our Unity Mass Choir, Male Voice Choir, Sunbeam Choir, Youth Choir, Women's Day Choir, and the Praise Team. Be available every Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday for weekend and mid-week services and various rehearsals. Must be flexible enough to play for extra services that happen throughout the year such as revivals and all holiday services. Also, must be available for church weddings and funerals.

The successful candidate should be able to play fluently by music and must be very proficient at playing by ear. He/She must be experienced with recording and sound equipment. He/She will have the responsibility of overseeing and training sound technicians and leading the recording ministry which includes the weekly recording of services and annual church choir album projects. Must be able to organize and lead our annual local concert tours that take place every summer; and occasionally overseas.
