Reporting to the Director General, the Director of Business Development will build on and work with the established infrastructure, including country specific materials, publications and existing BCAA branding. Whilst BCAA is headquartered in Bermuda a large percentage of the time will be interacting with teams overseas and travelling to promote the merits of the Bermuda Registry.

BCAA is an aviation regulatory agency, with the tenth (10th) largest aircraft registry in the world. Our staff of pilots, engineers and related administrative functions are available to support the development of contacts and materials, in keeping with the directives of the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) and the UK CAA through Air Safety Support International Limited.

Relevant Experience:

The successful candidate must demonstrate a commitment to continued professional growth and development and remain abreast of technical, legislative, regulatory, and any other related changes. A diplomatic approach to this work is required along with a cultural awareness for working in a multicultural environment
