- Relevant professional experience carrying out data recording/entry in a scientific/ computerized environment and working shifts would be an asset.
- Excellent communication skills (written, verbal and listening). Must be able to present, speak to the public and deal with clients at all levels internal and external to the organization.
- A strong sense of loyalty, motivation, dedication and a high degree of commitment and interest/passion for weather.
- Demonstrated ability to make rapid and effective decisions in reaction to changing weather patterns as well as the ability to react calmly and prioritize effectively during periods of high activity and workload.
- Good analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Strong desire to continuously improve skills and knowledge.
- Proficient with the Microsoft Office suite of products (Outlook, Excel, Word and PowerPoint) and be proficient with the use of technology and computer equipment in general.
- Reliable and trustworthy with respect for authority and the rules.
- Self-motivated and an independent thinker with a strong commitment to delivering high quality customer service.
- Strong interpersonal skills and an excellent team player with the ability to work independently.
