



## **TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES AT BHS**

At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, STEAM, community service and leadership development. **We are currently seeking the following for September 2021:**

### **Teacher of Art, Textiles, Photography, DT, Head of Year and Duke of Edinburgh Awards Leader**

This position requires the teaching of Art (including Fine Art, 3D, Ceramics and Digital Art) to students from Years 7 to 9, with the additional ability of specialization in Textiles, Photography and DT at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma Standard/Higer Level (teaching IB Visual Arts and supervising Visual Arts Extended Essays). The successful candidate will have experience with preparing student samples of coursework for external moderation and digital uploading for GCSE and DP. Proficiency in digital software and knowledge of various social media platforms for student use and for promotion of students' work, would be an asset. This position also involves the pastoral leadership of a Year group. The successful candidate will also be responsible for the coordination of all aspects of the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze and Silver Awards programme.

### **Teacher of Psychology, TOK, PSHE, Global Citizenship and Head of Year**

This position requires the teaching of Psychology at the IB Diploma Standard/Higer Levels. The successful candidate will also be required to teach Global Citizenship, PSHE (Personal, Social Health Education) and IB TOK (Theory of Knowledge). This position may also involve the pastoral leadership of a Year group.

**We are currently seeking the following for January 2022:**

### **Teacher of English, PSHE and Global Citizenship**

This position requires the teaching of English from Years 7 to 9 and at the IGCSE Level. The successful candidate will also be required to teach PSHE (Personal, Social Health Education) and Global Citizenship.

Applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a Bachelor's degree in the teaching subject and formal teacher training certification. Proven success and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject(s) would be a requirement for these vacancies. A willingness to contribute to the School's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should also be able to integrate technology in the classroom. Applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.
