The Role

We are seeking for our Bermuda office a dynamic and hardworking individual. Your responsibilities will include:

- Review of quarterly and annual Bermuda statutory reporting for Bermuda reinsurance companies, including a dual Class 4 and Class E reinsurance company and two Class C reinsurance companies. This includes review of BSCR models, U.S. GAAP financial statements, CISOs, surveys and other filing requirements
- Preparation and review of quarterly legal entity board and audit committee reporting
- Assistance in interpreting and documenting developments in regulatory requirements and maintaining Bermuda regulatory compliance
- Documentation, review and oversight of accounting policies and transactions impacting the Bermuda reinsurance companies under U.S. GAAP
- Leadership role in providing accounting policy oversight for accounting policy implementation projects for the Group and Bermuda reinsurance companies, including U.S. GAAP Long Duration Targeted Improvements (LDTI) and IFRS17
- Preparation of documentation supporting financial reporting internal controls and processes, in compliance with Sarbanes-Oxley Act documentation
- Significant coordination and communication with teams in other PartnerRe locations globally including local legal entity finance, investments, FP&A, financial operations, legal, actuarial, risk management, tax, internal audit, and external auditors
- Support for the PartnerRe Group reporting, including the Group's Annual report on Form 20-F filed with the SEC, quarterly Group Audit Committee reports and press releases and Group Bermuda statutory reporting
- Compilation and review of financial results for various surveys, third party requests and other ad-hoc external reporting related projects, as requested.
- Involvement in ad-hoc projects such as process and control documentation, and development of enhancements to statutory reporting capabilities within PeopleSoft system

Skills Required

- Strong, clear, timely and effective communication skills
- High degree of attention to detail, ensuring information produced is complete, accurate and of a high standard
- Strong technical accounting background with practical experience in applying complex accounting standards in the (re)insurance industry
- Ability to oversee timelines and manage projects to meet or exceed all deadlines
- Excellent written and organizational skills
- Ability and desire to identify and execute continuous improvements to existing processes, as well as implement new processes
- Self-starter with ability to work collaboratively across organizational and geographical boundaries, actively participating during meetings and conference calls

- Strong work ethic, willing and able to work evenings, weekends and public holidays as required to meet deadlines or address urgent matters as they arise

Qualifications and Experience Required

- Professional accounting designation (CA/CPA or equivalent) with a minimum of 10 years' experience in the (re)insurance industry
- Strong up-to-date technical knowledge and experience in dealing with complex US GAAP and SEC accounting, disclosure and reporting matters as it applies to both non-life and life reinsurance companies (including related to reinsurance transactions; consolidation; variable interest entities; investments; foreign exchange)
- Strong up-to-date technical knowledge and significant practical experience with Bermuda regulatory reporting for general and long-term business, including preparation or review of the BSCR model
- Knowledge and experience with US GAAP LDTI and/or IFRS17 would be a significant asset
- Significant practical experience compiling and/or reviewing US GAAP financial statements and SEC filings
- Practical experience using Workiva in preparing, reviewing and filing reports
- Significant experience working with and understanding different cultures within a global organization
- Ability to work independently and experience effectively managing and reviewing the work of others
- Proven experience in leading or executing ad-hoc projects successfully
