SENIOR MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIST

LABORATORY

The Senior Technologist directs the planning, coordination and supervising of all functions within the Histology/Cytology area, including testing, staff training, and inventory control and equipment maintenance. The Senior Technologist develops, implements and revises policies and procedures according to the established departmental protocol.

Key responsibilities include:

- Assisting the Laboratory Management Team in monitoring the operations for the designated area
- Assisting Pathologists in the development and implementation of clinical tests
- Supervising and assigning work to support staff
- Assisting with the training and orientation of new technical staff and visiting students
- Monitoring employee performances and evaluations
- Ensuring proper instrument and equipment operation, troubleshoots and performs minor repair on equipment
- Preparing monthly statistical reports of tests
- Maintaining inventory and requisition of supplies for designated area
- Keeps abreast of new developments in technology and equipment

Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology, Higher National Certificate, Diploma in Medical Technology or equivalent
- Registration with a professional licensing body in medical technology such as A.S.C.P. or equivalent
- Must be able to register with the Council for Allied Health Professions
- Diploma in Supervisory Management preferred or must be completed after appointment
- Not less than five (5) years post graduate experience in a medical laboratory

Schedule: Participates in a shift rotation to include weekends and public holidays. Hours of work may be adjusted to meet the changing demands on the Pathology services required.

MEDICAL TECHNOLOGISTS

LABORATORY

The Medical Technologist performs clinical laboratory analyses on biological specimens providing information for the diagnosis, prevention, or treatment of disease in a safe and effective manner. Technologists will be required to rotate through any facility associated with the Bermuda Hospitals Board and any section where they have experience.

Requirements:

- BSc Degree in Medical Technology or registered technologist with two to five years post qualification experience in Haematology, Biochemistry, Blood Transfusion and Microbiology.
- Must be registered with the ASCP, HPC or CSMLS or equivalent

Schedule: Technologists will be expected to provide optimal coverage of the laboratory services over a 24 hour period, 7 days a week including public holidays. This includes on call coverage.

Closing date for applications is: 5 July 2021. Pre-employment substance abuse screening is mandatory for all successful candidates.
