Position Summary

The VP Chief Actuary will be responsible for overseeing key actuarial functions including pricing, modeling and financial reporting for Bermuda based Athene Life Re. This leadership role provides strategic direction and technical oversight and ensures compliance with regulatory requirements and guidelines regarding actuarial practices and communicates with key stakeholders across the organization.

Responsibilities

- Provide thought leadership on various cross-functional teams supporting the business including actuarial, finance, and risk, and be an active member of the management team;
- Monitor the solvency position under the Economic Balance Sheet including modifications to the framework;
- Oversee the pricing of the reinsurance deals for flow and block, and ensuring appropriate standards and return thresholds;
- Oversee the financial close on a US GAAP and statutory basis, as well as the financial planning for the reinsurance segment;
- Design and implement an appropriate financial control environment for the company;
- Represent the business on for pricing, U.S. GAAP and related financial operations in interactions with parent and affiliated companies' financial and investment departments, state regulators, actuarial department, in-house and outside counsel, auditors, systems support departments, etc.;
- Ensure the regular review of all the actuarial assumptions and recommend changes as appropriate; and
- Provide support beyond core financial actuarial responsibilities including capital raise initiatives, rating agency diligence, etc.

Credentials and Experience

- Bachelor's degree in mathematics, actuarial science, or related field;
- Designation as a Fellow in the Society of Actuaries or the Canadian Institute of Actuaries, and Member of the American Academy of Actuaries;
- 8+ years' experience working in the life insurance industry in U.S GAAP financial reporting and modeling areas of practice;
- 5+ years' experience working with the Bermuda long term insurer reporting and regulations; and
- Ability to set and manage priorities in a changing work environment is essential.
