Bye-Election for 2nd Vice President

In accordance with Article XIII 2. (v) of the Bermuda Public Services Union's (BPSU) Constitution, a Bye-election to fill the position of 2nd Vice President of the Bermuda Public Services Union will be held on Tuesday, August 24, 2021, at the National Sports Centre (north field building), in Devonshire Parish. Polling will take place from 8:30 am to 8:30 pm.

An Advanced Poll will be held on Tuesday, August 17, 2021, at the National Sports Centre (north field building) Devonshire Parish. Polling will take place from 8:30 am to 8:30 pm. To be permitted to vote in the Advanced Poll, members must provide the Secretariat with proof that they will either be off-Island or incapacitated on the day of the Bye-election, Tuesday, August 24, 2021. Acceptable forms of proof include a copy of an airline ticket or a letter from a physician confirming a member's incapacity on Tuesday, August 24, 2021.

Acceptable forms of identification for both the Advanced Poll and the Bye-Election include:

- 1. BPSU Photo ID Membership Card
- 2. Workplace Photo ID
- 3. Passport
- 4. Driver's License
- 5. Voter's Registration Card

The Membership Register will be available for inspection at the Bermuda Public Services Union Secretariat from Monday, July 19, 2021 to Tuesday, August 10, 2021 only. For purposes of the upcoming Bye-election, no additions will be made to the Membership Register after Tuesday, August 10, 2021.
