We invite applications for the position of **Senior Actuary** in its Bermuda office. The role of the successful applicant will involve leading due diligence, structuring and pricing of life reinsurance transactions.

The main responsibilities of the position are as follows:

- Taking the lead in performing due diligence, structuring and pricing of life reinsurance contracts with material investment risks;
- Working with the Company's key stakeholders and other colleagues to ensure appropriate underwriting of other business types, e.g. P/C legacy or prospective cat business;
- Presenting findings on prospective transactions to management and the Board of Directors;
- Responding to any queries from regulators on prospective or previous transactions or any regulatory filings;
- Contributing to other operational areas to meet the Company's needs, e.g. assisting with the preparation of regulatory filings, documenting risk reviews, and other projects requested by management or the Board of Directors; and
- Keeping up to date with capital market and (re)insurance industry activities and trends.

Qualifications:

- FSA, FIA qualification or equivalent professional designation with a minimum of three years' post qualified experience in life reinsurance;
- Technical expert in life products and associated risks (e.g. FIA and annuity) and good understanding of ALM and investments;
- Proven ability to model complex life insurance / annuity portfolios, including products with policyholder participation;
- Good understanding of Bermuda, Solvency II, and US capital frameworks and its application to life risk and annuity products;
- Experience in working with Risk Agility FM/MoSes is preferred;
- Advanced use of Excel, Access with solid PowerPoint skill;
- Must be problem solver with the ability to identify and initiate appropriate actions to remediate;
- Strong team player with ability to work in a collaborative environment;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills;
- Ideal candidate will also have a strong local and global network to contribute value to the enterprise;
- Self-motivated, strong sense of urgency, highly organized and able to effectively manage multiple priorities and deadlines in a fast-paced business environment and;
