The successful candidate will be responsible for managing the Property and Energy Claims department in Bermuda. The appropriate candidate will be a self-starter who can immediately handle a diverse range of claims and responsibilities. This position will report to the Executive Vice President, Head of Bermuda and Global Markets Claims Group.

Responsibilities Include:

- The adjustment of selected high exposure, complex First Party Property and Energy claims within a significant authority level.
- Approve reserves, settlements, payments, reservation of rights, denials and other actions consistent with authority.
- Manage and develop Bermuda property claims staff and evaluate department staffing requirements.
- Maintaining a pending of first party property claim files with responsibility for the investigation, negotiation and settlement of these claims within an established settlement authority and under supervision of the EVP of the Department.
- Evaluating, analyze and handle claims under various types of commercial property and energy policies.
- Managing a property claim pending, direct effective use of outside vendors, control costs, analyze and report trends.

- Ascertain claim values and readily interpret policy language.
