- ▶ **Senior** – a minimum of eighteen (18) months of recent relevant experience in a similar position with prior experience working for a public accounting, professional services, or actuarial consultancy firm strongly preferred; successful candidates should be actively pursuing a professional actuarial designation with the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries, Society of Actuaries, Casualty Actuarial Society, or other internationally recognized professional actuarial association, with a minimum of three actuarial exams completed
- ▶ **Manager** – a minimum of four (4) years of recent relevant experience in a similar position with prior experience working for a public accounting, professional services, or actuarial consultancy firm strongly preferred; successful candidates should be actively pursuing a professional actuarial designation with the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries, Society of Actuaries, Casualty Actuarial Society, or other internationally recognized professional actuarial association, with a minimum of five actuarial exams completed. The successful candidates are also expected to demonstrate excellent project management skills, inspire teamwork and responsibility with engagement team members, and participate in business development activities
