FALL NOTICE

All members of the public are reminded to adhere to The Bermuda National Parks Act 1986, 2009 and 2017 Amendments and The Bermuda National Parks Regulations 1988 and 2018 Amendment while visiting Bermuda's National Parks. Any person who contravenes a provision of the National Parks Act or any regulations made thereunder commits an offence against this act.

PERMITS

- Please note that all metal detector permits expire December 31st of the previous year and a renewed permit is necessary for this year.
- For those who wish to fly a Small Unmanned Aircraft (SUA) in any National Park, must have a permit issued by the Department of Parks.
- All Park Patrons are reminded that Special Permits should be sought out first from the Department of Parks if they plan to have events and activities within the National Park System.
- All of the mentioned permits can be sought from the Department of Parks Office, located at Global House, 43 Church Street, Hamilton HM 12.

DOGS IN NATIONAL PARKS

- From the 1st of November to the 31st of March in any year, dogs are **PERMITTED** to be on any public beach.
- Dogs must be on a leash at **ALL** times with leash length no greater than 3 metres.
- For safety and health reasons dogs are **NOT PERMITTED** on playgrounds in National Parks.
- Please remember to pick up after dogs and dispose of waste appropriately.

HORSES IN NATIONAL PARKS

Beaches: From the 1st of November to the 30th April, in any year, no person shall take or ride a horse on Horseshoe Bay Beach in South Shore Park or on the beaches in John Smiths Bay Park and Elbow Beach Park, but may take or ride a horse on all other public beaches below the high tide water mark at any time.

BONFIRES IN NATIONAL PARKS

- All bonfires require a Special Permit which must be obtained from the Department of Parks office.
- Upon obtaining a Special Permit, persons will receive all necessary information about the terms and conditions for proper bonfire conduct within National Parks.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT IN NATIONAL PARKS

- Motorcross/off-road motorcycle activity strictly prohibited.
- RC/model powerboat operation allowed at Kindly Field Park with a Special Permit. Unauthorized RC/model powerboat operation is strictly prohibited.
