POSITION OF TRANSITIONAL CANON RESIDENTIARY

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Constitution of the Anglican Church of Bermuda, the Bishop of Bermuda is aiming to appoint a Transitional Canon Residentiary and Sub Dean.

In addition to providing ongoing pastoral care, administrative oversight of the Cathedral office and staff and excellent communication skills across all age groups, the successful candidate will need to be an experienced, prayerful Anglican priest of good standing, in communion with the Archbishop of Canterbury and of strong Biblical conviction. The Priest will need to have significant experience in Cathedral ministry and be experienced and comfortable in a multi-racial environment. Particularly, it is required that the candidate have recognized formal training and proven experience in transitional ministry to assist the Vestry and Cathedral congregation to formulate a strategic plan for the ministry of the church and the leadership challenges of the next generation. The successful candidate will have a close personal and working relationship with the Bishop, who is also the Dean of the Cathedral.

Three current written references will be required alongside a curriculum vitae that demonstrates success in building on the foundation laid in order to lead the congregations forward towards a new future engaging the cultural and COVID related shifts in church and society in a missional way.

Other attributes looked for will include experience in theological education to assist the Director of Training and Discipleship in equipping local lay persons for a variety of ministry contexts up to and including ordination; gifts in evangelism and the ability to foster relationships with those outside of the church. Strong administrative skills are an asset for the position.

The appointment is for a period of up to three years commencing as soon as practically possible at the end of which it is anticipated that clear, owned next steps are laid out for the future ministry and leadership of the Cathedral in the City of Hamilton, the Diocese of Bermuda and Anglican Communion, as the Lord leads.
