- o Must be able to plan engaging units of enquiry to be explored in depth and use assessment to drive the planning process; use a range and balance of teaching strategies; use technology to enhance learning
- o Experience with remote teaching and learning is preferred; must be able to multitask
- o Establish a safe, purposeful and stimulating environment
- o Lead and participate in after school clubs and be fully committed to taking an active part in all areas of school life
- o Must be a keen outdoors person committed, creative, adventurous and athletic
- o Must be flexible and willing to adapt to support the school's direction and operation
- o Must be keen to collaborate and share specialist expertise, constantly demonstrating the school's core values
- o Must be a fitting ambassador for the school and communicate with confidence across diverse audiences and situations, using their expertise to build strong relationships with students, parents and the community
