The Water and Waste Water Process Controller is mainly responsible for overseeing and runnning the Reverse Osmosis (ROP) and Oily Water Treatment Plants (OWTP) ensuring the proper operation and maintenance of Clean & Oily Water Treatment. The role involves acting as Spill Team Leader operating the PACS 1000. The incumbent also occasionally operates and maintains the Hydrocarbon Recovery Centres.
