The Distribution Systems Operator works on shifts and is mainly responsible for performing control and monitoring tasks on both Bulk Generation and Transmission and Distribution systems to ensure continuous supply of electricity. The post holder coordinates system activities during critical alarms, emergencies or shutdowns and performs switching procedures for planned outages. Responsibilities also involve performance evaluation, testing and commissioning of modified or new control systems. Other responsibilities include BELCO system control, as well as analysis and reporting on overall BELCO system performance.

The Distribution Systems Operator must communicate effectively with both Energy Supply and Energy Delivery operational personnel. The post holder provides guidance and on-the-job training to team members.

Key Responsibilities

- Monitoring the general status of the transmission and distribution networks
- Responding to customers' enquiries and issues
- Disseminating information to troubleshooting crews
- Logging call information, completing job closeouts, preparing follow-up work requests
- Reviewing weather status and notifying operations personnel accordingly
- The post holder provides guidance and on-the-job training to team members
