Key responsibilities include:

- Assessing patient's needs on arrival e.g. size of chair required, mobility/access needed for a wheelchair/use of a bed if the patient is nervous and to provide adequate private service
- Drawing blood specimens from patient of all ages by venipuncture and skin puncture as needed for medical tests
- Collecting and return samples from patients in the OP phlebotomy area and IP wards in a timely manner
- Ensuring the safe/correct disposal of sharps, syringes and items contaminated with blood
- Performing all duties and responsibilities in a prompt, accurate and reliable manner according to established hospital and departmental policies and procedures.
- Adhering strictly to safety and infection control procedures while performing all duties

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Certification in phlebotomy with appropriate training with a minimum of 1 years' experience
- Successful completion of 150 venipunctures and 50 finger sticks
- Demonstrable experience in dealing with patients and/or the general public
