The post holder works directly under the Forensic/Clinical Psychologist I ("Psychologist I"), and from time to time, as directed by more senior personnel in the Unit or the Director, with responsibility for providing a wide range of psychological assessments, intervention and treatment to individual clients and families, to reduce recidivism risks and related triggers. In addition, the post holder has input and supervision into the team of assigned Senior Probation Officers and offender groups, in accordance with the relevant legislation, mandates, policies and procedures.

Interested applicants must possess a doctoral degree in Forensic or Clinical Psychology, with proven skills in assessment and treatment of specialized and/or high-risk offender groups in a criminal justice setting; with at least five years' post qualification experience in dealing with specialized offender, offence specific populations is required. Applicants who do not possess a doctoral degree may also be considered for the post if they possess a Master's degree (Chartered Psychologist with the British Psychological Society) in Forensic or Clinical Psychology, with at least six years post qualification experience in dealing with specialized offender or offence specific populations. Two years' cumulative supervisory experience is an asset. Additionally, interested applicants must be able to meet the criteria for registration with the Bermuda Psychological Council.
