Senior Business Analyst

Reporting to the VP, Programme Management, the Senior Business Analyst is responsible for ensuring daily operations of systems across several departments, improving existing business processes and IT products, and implementing new business-oriented IT systems.

- Developing information systems strategies to meet business goals with the data and systems architect, business users, and identifying cost/benefit impact to the company of proposed projects in conjunction with the Vendor Management Office and the business sponsors
- Evaluating business objectives that require new systems or enhancements to existing systems to determine feasibility, cost, time required and compatibility with current systems
- Coordinating and overseeing the work of other business analysts as required for specific projects
- Development and execution of test plans for system and process changes
- Undertake other reasonable duties as requested by Management

- University degree in business administration or equivalent qualification with a minimum of eight years' relevant experience in a banking environment
- Certification in Business Analysis would be an asset
- Knowledge of Oracle's FlexCube, OBPAY, OBRRN as well as SWIFT (including ISO2022) and Trade Thru systems
- Proven experience in the utilisation of a structured business analysis methodology
- Ability to communicate and present research, design, testing and implementation plans to business associates including executive stakeholders, both verbally and in writing with all levels of the organisation
- Proficient in Microsoft Office suite of applications
- Ability to travel internationally
