Information and Cyber Security

- Implement and test monitoring and automation tools and scripts
- Manage the Security Awareness Programme for bank employees
- Responding to any security alerts and working with vendors to resolve
- Supporting the annual cyber security incident tabletop exercise
- Identifying any areas across the bank that can be further secured
- Being an active member of the Bermuda Bankers Association Cyber Security sub-committee

Application and Infrastructure Support

- Monitor and maintain the availability and technical integrity of the bank's systems
- Analyse, troubleshoot and resolve user queries, working closely with other team members and external support vendors as required
- Prioritize requests and incidents
- Support and guide business users to review, test and apply data and software releases
- Execute and/or manage all stages of the Software Lifecycle, from analysis, development, unit testing and documentation to support User Acceptance Testing and deployment
