## Speech-Language Pathologist - Full Time

Responsibilities and duties include, but are not limited to:

- To select and use appropriate standardized and nonstandardized assessment measures to analyze, interpret and report results.
- To provide clinical assessment and intervention to students with a range of conditions/disabilities and complex social and functional needs.
- Design and lead students in sessions that are engaging and interactive, and follow best practice in a progressive, flexible and personalized approach.
- Develop positive relationships with students to support their social and emotional learning.
- Approach working with students in a team-centered environment.
- Attend events outside of school hours such as: weekly staff meetings, open houses and professional development sessions.
- Work on a modified school-year calendar.
- Enjoy working with children in a busy educational setting.

## Qualifications:

- A master's degree in Speech-Language Pathology Have obtained certification to practice as a Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) through ASHA, SAC, or the RCSLT or other national governing body as per the mutual recognition agreement (MRA), and be licensed/registered to practice as a Speech-Language Pathologist in their home jurisdiction (e.g., state or province).
- A minimum of three years' experience providing speechlanguage intervention.
- Licensed with the Bermuda Health Council or be eligible to obtain a license
- SCARS and CPR/First Aid certified, or available to attend training certification.
