Key responsibilities include:

- Assigns, teaches and directs other nursing personnel as required
- Assumes in-charge duties as required

Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- Registered Nurse with Bachelor's Degree or Diploma from an accredited institution
- Current registration as required by the Bermuda Nursing Council
- Two years experience as a Registered Nurse
- Current certifications: CPR and I.V
- Experience in Physical assessment essential
- Demonstrated knowledge and clinical competencies
- Nursing Certification in Palliative Care &/or Long Term Care preferred or a commitment to complete the courses within the first year of employment.

REGISTERED NURSE – POST ANAESTHESIA CARE UNIT (PACU):

Key responsibilities include:

- Gives direct patient care (simple to complex)
- Performs dependent functions as indicated in the Surgical plan of care
- Utilizes the nursing process and develops a nursing care plan for each assigned patient
- Acts as a patient advocate, communicating between patient, family and other members of the health team
- Initiates and participates in patient care conferences
- Utilizes clinical, hospital and community resources
- Uses equipment and supplies in a safe and economical manner
- Assigns teaches and directs other nursing personnel as required
- Assumes in-charge duties as required
- Assumes responsibility for professional development by participating in continuing education programmes, keeping current with professional literature and participating in professional organizations

Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- Registered Nurse with Bachelor's Degree or Diploma from an accredited institution
- Current registration as required by the Bermuda Nursing Council
- Two years of continuous employment /experience in a current PACU setting
- Current certifications: CPR, ACLS/ ECG monitoring and I.V.
- Strong experience in Patient assessment essential
- Demonstrated knowledge and clinical competencies

IMAGING TECHNOLOGIST – DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING (CAT SCAN):

Key Responsibilities include:

- Actions Physicians' requisitions, produces and evaluates images for diagnostic clarity and possible pathology. Communicates deviations from quality control norms to the Imaging Resource Technologist, Senior Imaging Technologist or Radiologist/Cardiologist as required
- Operates and maintains Imaging and Imaging support equipment (laser printer, PACS, etcetera) in a safe and efficient manner
- Transports and uses portable equipment to required hospital areas to perform imaging procedures. Observes all BHB Critical Care area policies, sterile techniques and anesthesia safety precautions
- Accepts responsibility for continuing competencies through on-going professional development including participation in educational programs
- Practices Radiation Safety and Infection Control techniques at all times
- May be required to rotate through the imaging modalities to gain experience and / or credentials to work in specialized areas based upon certifications. The modalities include Radiology, CAT Scan, MRI, Nuclear Medicine, Mammography and Bone Density

Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- Undergraduate degree in Medical Imaging or Radiologic Technology from an accredited institution
- Registration / certification from an accredited program: Radiology, CAT scan, MRI, Nuclear Medicine, Mammography and Bone Density
- Minimum of two (2) years of post-graduate experience preferred
- Registration with the Allied Health Professions Council
- Current ARRT/CAMRT/DCRR or equivalent
- Level 2 Imaging Technologist
 - In addition to Level 1 certification, the Imaging Technologist must have one (1) or more certifications in the applicable Primary and/ or Post Primary Pathways:
 - Mammography
 - Cat Scan
 - Bone Densitometry

Closing date for applications is June 16, 2022. Pre-employment substance abuse screening is mandatory for all successful candidates.
