The Maritime Enforcement Specialist – Coast Guard Unit Second-in-Command works in support of the Coast Guard Unit Commander for the excellent order, discipline, welfare and administration of the Coast Guard Unit. The Coast Guard Unit Second-in-Command assist with ensuring the unit is enforcing applicable law in Bermuda's territorial waters, search and rescue, responding to disasters and environmental protection.

The post-holder must possess a Bachelor's Degree, a Marine & Ports C Licence, and an RYA Advanced Powerboat Certification. In addition, they must have five (5) years of experience in a senior or maritime role within the RBR. The post-holder should be a commissioned officer or a soldier with a recommendation to the commission. Also, the post-holder must pass all RBR Mandatory Annual Training Tests and the Coast Guard Unit Swim Test.

The Coast Guard Unit Second-in-Command is considered an essential level post; therefore, the post-holder must be capable of working under stressful, high-risk conditions in Bermuda waters.

They also must have a Marine & Ports C Licence and an RYA Advanced Powerboat Certification. The post-holder must hold factory certifications for engine maintenance. In addition, they must have five (5) years of experience within the RBR (or another military unit) holding the rank of Corporal. Prior small boat handling experience is required. The post-holder must pass all RBR Mandatory Annual Training Tests and the Coast Guard Unit Swim Test.
