Key responsibilities include:

- Conducts mental health assessments/triage of the presenting symptoms of individuals referred to Outpatient Services
- Manages assigned case load, conducts assessments and triage of referred patients/ clients, provides support to Clinic Triage Nurse (CTN) and supervises the work of support staff as applicable
- Administers medications to patients/clients
- Orders medications for patients/clients
- Encourages support staff to deliver person-centered care that enables patients/clients to engage in meaningful activities and relationships
- Engages members of the public in the promotion of mental health/wellbeing and relapse prevention
- Acts as Case Manager for assigned clients or groups of patients to develop and implement treatment plans and programs
- Liaises with care givers, relatives, and other care providers for best outcomes of patients/clients

Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- Registered Psychiatric Nurse or equivalent with a minimum of three years post graduate experience
- Certificate in Community Psychiatric Nursing or equivalent, preferred with a three years of experience working in a community mental health setting
- Current registration with the Bermuda Nursing Council
- Valid car driver's license
