Reinsurance Accountant

Catalina is seeking a motivated and ambitious individual for its Finance team as Reinsurance Accountant, to join the Bermuda team, primarily responsible for the reinsurance accounting for its flagship reinsurer, Catalina General Insurance Ltd. The role is based in Bermuda and reports to the Financial Controller.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform all aspects of reinsurance accounting including administration of claim settlements, loss reporting and reserving with actuaries, brokers and claim handlers;
- Assist with the preparation of U.S. GAAP financials and statutory returns for the Bermuda entities;
- Ensure timely and appropriate acknowledgement of claims reported by brokers and third-party claim handlers;
- Submit claims notices and supporting documentation to the appropriate manager for approval in line with the Company claims approval process and authority limits;
- Coordinate the quarterly loss reporting process with claim managers, actuaries, brokers and claim handlers;
- Evaluate reinsurance claims notices to ensure that the submissions are in line with the terms and conditions of the contracts;
- Assist with establishing required Letters of Credit and Trust Accounts;
- Assist with accounting and reporting of assumed and ceded treaties, including commutations for quarterly reporting and audit;
- · Assist with the integration of Loss Portfolio Transfers and acquired books of business;
- Manage the inter-group QS process for business assumed by the company, including liaising with affiliated
 entities to reconcile and settle outstanding balances and preparing loss report submissions to ceded entities;
- Provide claims and reserve data to the actuarial team for the quarter-end close process;
- Independent analysis and solving of complex reinsurance accounting issues;
- Support with the annual external audit of Catalina General Insurance Ltd.;
- Preparation of accounting memos to support U.S. GAAP accounting;
- Research of accounting literature to resolve U.S. GAAP queries and keep abreast of developments; and
- Performing any related duties that may arise.

Candidate Competencies and Qualifications

- CA, CPA, ACA or equivalent internationally recognized accounting qualification;
- A minimum of three years post qualifying work experience, which should be in the insurance or reinsurance (non-life) industry or with an accounting firm with significant reinsurance experience;

- Solid understanding of accounting for reinsurance transactions, including loss portfolio transfers;
- · Advanced Excel spreadsheet skills;
- · Strong organizational and analytical skills;

- Willingness to work evenings and weekends, as needed.
