- Preparing and managing the quarterly debt compliance reporting for the Group;
- Manage all aspects of reinsurance accounting, including administration of claim settlements, loss reporting and reserving with actuaries, brokers and claim handlers;
- Monitoring regulatory and U.S. GAAP developments and the impact on the Group; and
- Assist in preparing accounting memos to support the U.S. GAAP accounting treatment for non-routine transactions, complex reinsurance transactions and fair value accounting of new acquisitions and investments.

### Candidate Competencies and Qualifications

- An internationally recognized accounting certification (C.A., CPA or ACCA) is required;
- A minimum of seven years post qualifying work experience in the insurance or reinsurance industry, of which at least two should be in a leadership role;
- Solid understanding of accounting for complex reinsurance transactions, including loss portfolio transfers.
- Detailed knowledge of U.S. GAAP and the Bermuda Solvency Capital Requirements framework;
- Detailed knowledge of accounting for standard and alternative investments;
- Must have advanced working knowledge of Microsoft Office suite;
- Proven ability to work well under pressure, meet tight deadlines and respond to changing priorities;
- Ability to work in a team-oriented environment; and
- Working knowledge of SunGL, VisionXL and ClearWater would be an advantage.
