TEACHING POSITION

The school offers an Early Years Programme, the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) and UK National Curriculum from Years 1 to 9, the IGCSE in Year 10 & 11, and the IB Diploma Programme, IB Career-related Programme (using BTEC subjects), IB Individual Subjects, and a Dual Enrolment programme with the Bermuda College in Year 12 & 13. The balance between the two aspects will depend on demand for certain subjects. Experience at IGCSE PE and BTEC Sport is a key requirement. The candidate will also participate in the Activity Afternoon provision, coach teams in proportion to their teaching load, and lead our High-Performance programmes.

Requirements:

Applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Educators Council teacher license, be able to show at least 3 years' Secondary School teaching experience in the required subject, hold an undergraduate degree preferably aligned with the subject they will be teaching, a professional teaching qualification (PGCE or equivalent) at the appropriate school level, and be able to show recent teaching experience in the education programmes applicable to the post (UK National Curriculum, I/GCSE, International Baccalaureate, BTEC). Applicants must be able to relate positively to students, staff and parents with proven external examination success being an essential component. They must also be prepared to contribute to the school's pastoral and co-curricular programmes..
