The Programme Manager is responsible for overseeing the day-to-day operations of one of Endeavour's Forts which is a Royal Yachting Association Recognised Training Centre.

This position leads the delivery of Endeavour's experiential learning programmes ensuring high quality and adherence to all safety standards. The successful candidate will bring exceptional interpersonal and effective communication skills to foster positive relationships with young people, their families, and educators.

Key responsibilities:

- Manages the daily operations of the designated facility ensuring a high standard of maintenance and responsible operation and care for all assets and facilities
- Oversees programme delivery and facilitation of classroom and on-water instruction ensuring a fun, quality learning experience for all skill levels and abilities
- Supervises and provides mentorship and support to full-time and seasonal instructors and facilitates regular performance appraisals
- Implements safety precautions to ensure the safety and wellbeing of staff and participants are prioritised at all times
- Builds and maintains relationships with young people and their families to support engagement and retention across programmes
- Communicates positively and effectively with participants, parents, teachers, and community partners
- Reports regularly on programme outcomes using online system
- Ensures the facility, classroom, docks, marine fleet, and grounds are kept in good order, clean, organised and secure at all times
