### REQUIRED INFORMATION AND MATERIALS

Candidates are required to have the following information or materials available to complete their application:

- A letter of application (not to exceed 5 pages) that succinctly addresses the opportunities and challenges identified in the Position Profile and
  demonstrates how the candidate's experience and professional qualifications prepare them to serve as the President of Bermuda College.
- A current resume including an email address and cellular telephone number.
- A list of eight (8) references: example, two to three supervisors, two to three direct reports, and two to three faculty and/or staff members from current and former institutions.
