- Assist in reporting reserving results to Company and Group leadership
- Collaborate with other departments including underwriting, finance, claims, IT, and catastrophe modeling
- Help manage relationships and communication flows with external auditors and actuaries
- Assist in the production, interpretation and clear communication of analyses to support ad-hoc projects
- Analysis of claims trends to improve prediction of likely outcomes
- Support the future development of the actuarial reserving function and any associated business development work
- Support various other projects within the reserving and actuarial teams (e.g. claims inflation, reinsurance solutions, claims performance metrics and reserving trend analysis).

What you require for the role

- Minimum of 2 actuarial exams completed (CAS or equivalent)
- At least two years' experience within the P&C insurance and/or reinsurance industry focused on reserve analyses
- Familiarity with reinsurance terms, structures, and data
- Demonstrable ability to effectively communicate reserving and analytical findings
- Experience with programming in VBA, SQL, R and/or Python preferred
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively
