Duties and responsibilities will include but not be limited to:

- Perform water mains and service line installations and repairs to recognized public water industry standards, and make routine adjustments to pressures and flows in a safe and efficient manner
- Perform valve and meter installations and replacements to recognized public water industry standards
- Respond to customer service requests and emergency work as needed, and be willing to carry a pager or mobile phone while on standby duty, which is a 7 day, 24 hour rotating water department scheduled shift including weekends and public holidays
- Use and operate hand tools, mechanical equipment, and power tools and equipment required for the work in a safe and efficient manner
- Operate a variety of vehicular and stationary mechanical equipment such as a crane truck and fork lift, and heavy trucks in a safe and effective manner in routine situations
- Accurately utilize hand held computers in recording data including water meter readings
- Operate within an annual general maintenance schedule
- Collect and test water samples for chlorine and adjust chlorine disinfection equipment accordingly
- Any other duties as assigned

Qualifications, Skills & Experience:

- A minimum of three (3) years previous water utility related experience
- Be able to meet the physical requirements necessary to safely and effectively perform the required duties which will include some exposure to water, chemicals, hazardous materials, and noise: heavy lifting/moving, standing and climbing, working at heights as well as in confined spaces
- Able to work in inclement weather conditions outdoors
- Highly motivated and sufficiently mature to be able to work on own initiative with minimum or no supervision
- Able to accept responsibility for completing tasks in an economical and safe manner
- Strong ability to organize and prioritize demanding workloads or emergency situations with a commitment to meeting deadlines
- Ability to read, write and do arithmetic at a level required for the job
- Possess effective communication skills
- A sound and reliable work ethic and be willing to be “on call” and work extended hours including weekends and public holidays
- Must possess a valid heavy truck and construction machinery license

Experience in other branches of the water utility industry is highly desirable to enable the person to undertake whatever tasks may from time to time become necessary or specified.
