



## **National Academy Part-time Coaches**

The Bermuda Football Association under the direction of the Player Development Committee (PDC) is accepting applications Part-time National Academy Coaches.

### **Re: Part-time National Academy Coaches**

The National Academy coaching positions will require “open minded” coaches who are motivated to work as part of a team for the long term development of football here in Bermuda. They will be asked to coach at one age range, each season and to produce yearly reports in line with the technical requirements of the BFA. The coaches will deliver the BFA's technical syllabus throughout the year and will also assist in the development of the syllabus as an on-going document. Coaches will travel with teams to international tournaments as directed by the (PDC). The positions will report directly to the (PDC) and their duties will include but not limited to:

- Manage squad of players on all football matters
- Head up all recruitment for players for designated group.
- Assist in developing national teams syllabus
- Deliver syllabus at all sessions
- Attend all in-service training sessions
- Manage team in administration via BFA office
- Develop in conjunction with the (PDC) a year-long plan for the assigned group.
- Complete a report for each player in the group directed from BFA
- Attend all Senior men's National team games
- Travel with National teams to tournaments
