Candidates must offer the following:

- Masters degree in applied psychology, counselling, or social work with formal clinical training.
- Ability to work in a culturally sensitive and supportive manner at all times.
- A minimum of three years of clinical experience working in a supervised capacity with individuals and families in crisis.

Major duties and responsibilities include:

- Ability to approach cases using a family systems model and solution-focused strategies;
- Screen referrals to determine appropriate eligibility for Family Centre individual, family, or community and home-based services;
- Conduct clinical initial assessments of a client's personal, family and social background;
- Counsel children and early adolescents referred to the programme in psychological distress;
- Maintain caseload of clients who have complex personal and family problems;
- Clinical note-taking and collaborative development of treatment plans with the client and their family;
- Refer individuals to appropriate agencies and programmes needed by the client;
- Follow through on referrals to ensure that appropriate services are provided;
- Work with family of clients to advise of problems and gain support;
- Visit individuals in their homes;
- Prepare review reports on the progress of each client;
- Take part in team planning and delivery of therapeutic groups, holiday camps and summer programmes.
- Work as a team member in the Caring for Families Programme.
