Traffic Order BERMUDA END-TO-END AND MIDDLE-TO-END WALK SATURDAY, 7 MAY 2011

Notice is hereby given that in connection with the staging of the above event, the eastern side (nearest the Ferry Terminal) of Point Pleasant Road (Albuoy's Point) will be closed to all vehicular traffic on Saturday, 7 May 2011 from 9:00 a.m. until approximately 11:15 a.m.

The Bermuda Regiment Band will escort the walkers from Albuoy's Point along Front Street to the Cabinet Office. Traffic will be disrupted on Front Street during this time.

There will be no parking allowed on Point Pleasant Road from 6:00 a.m. until 11:15 a.m. Vehicular and pedestrian access to the western portion of Albuoy's Point (Royal Bermuda Yacht Club, Barr's Bay Park, Marine Police Office) will be allowed on the western side of the Bank of Bermuda.

In addition, the Bermuda Police are hereby authorized to close off streets or portions of streets in the area, direct traffic, and restrict and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
