- Serve as the Diocesan Director for Liturgical Music and act as a resource person to assist Choral and Music directors in the six parishes as required.

Applicants must posses the following qualifications:

- Professional training in music (BA or its equivalent) with keyboard skills in both organ and piano as well as proven abilities in choral conducting and voice training with at least five years experience in these areas.
- Specific Personal Qualities which must include:
 - People Skills ability to interact with people of all ages, races, nationalities and social status in a pastoral manner.
 - Leadership Skills ability to attract and inspire members of the choir and other music and liturgical ministries.
 - Organizational Skills ability to take initiative and coordinate activities relating to the above responsibilities at the parish level (Cathedral) as well as on the Diocesan Level.
