Catastrophe Modeling Group Manager

This position reports directly to the President and CEO, and will work within a team of experienced reinsurance underwriters and actuaries who are specialized in assuming on a worldwide basis, contracts with natural catastrophe exposures such as earthquakes, hurricanes and floods. The Catastrophe Modeling Group Manager will lead a small team in working closely with the Company's property, marine, casualty and underwriters to help them best understand and respond to the potential impact of natural as well as manmade catastrophe exposures.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- · Oversee the analysis of catastrophe exposure provided by clients
- Analyze changes in exposures; quantify and communicate corresponding impacts on modeled results at the portfolio level, to senior management
- Mentor members of the catastrophe modeling team and provide guidance in running detailed analysis on catastrophe software such as AIR, RMS or EQE
- Plan, develop and implement software tools designed to assess the quality of exposure data provided for various lines of business including property, marine, personal accident and specialty lines
- Manage the development and implementation of software/methodology to assist with pricing catastrophe exposed contracts both on a stand alone basis and as a marginal addition to the portfolio
- · Manage the integration of catastrophe modeling software into the day to day underwriting business workflow;
- · Oversee the Company's assessment of its catastrophe risk position on a contract by contract basis
- Manage and be responsible for the Company's overall portfolio accumulation from natural catastrophes and other manmade disasters for all lines of business
