

REQUEST FOR CREDENTIALS AND EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST NATIONAL SPORTS CENTRE, AQUATIC COMPLEX

WATERPROOF MEMBRANE CONTRACTOR SERVICES

The National Sports Centre is looking for qualified waterproof membrane contractors to install approx. 29,000 sq ft of membrane for the new Aquatic Complex.

The Aquatic Complex, which is presently under construction, includes the construction of a 50 meter 8 lane concrete swimming pool, a diving tower, spectator seating, change room facilities and mechanical and electrical systems. The construction is being managed on the behalf of the Board of Trustees of the National Sports Centre by Cannon Johnston Architecture Inc.

Proponents interested in providing the required waterproof membrane services are requested to submit their qualifications in an Expression of Interest format not exceeding ten (10) pages.

Expressions of Interest must include the following:

- Name(s) of Membrane Contractor (s) and their company, including the identification of the principals
- Credentials for each member of the roofing contracting team, including all relevant project management staff, trades personnel and support staff
- Specific experiences that relate to these product types.
- References
- Confirmation that the contractor is licensed by the membrane manufacturer to install the following products.
 - 1 Ethylene propylene diene monomer (EPDM sheet membrane)
 - 2 Lexcan Geolex Thermoplastic Polyolefin (TPO sheet membrane). A 1.5 mm thick, reinforced membrane for use in fully adhered and/or mechanically fastened system.
 - 3 Firestone FPP-R Flexible Polypropylene (FPP sheet membrane). A 1.5 mm thick reinforced membrane for use in fully adhered and/or mechanically fastened system.
 - 4 Or approved equal products

If the contractor is not licensed by the manufacturer to install these products then the contractor will be required to joint venture with a licensed installer of these products.

Selection will be based on previous experience and demonstrated success with these products. The Board of Trustees of the National Sports Centre reserves the right in its sole discretion to select a short list that it considers appropriate for this project. Only short listed proponents will be acknowledged.
