Front Office Supervisor

A highly motivated, organized and guest orientated individual is required. This challenging position requires a friendly disposition, positive manner, high degree of self-motivation and the ability to adapt to and perform multi tasks and duties. This position involves the ability to operate a busy Front Office ensuring flawless execution to the highest standards of guest service. Major responsibilities include but not limited to: Supervision of daily operations of Front Office, preparation of departmental schedules and payroll, preparation of weekly and monthly forecast reports, recruitment, training and continuous development of staff, planning and successful execution of groups and special events.

Minimum of 2 years' experience as a supervisor within the Front Office environment, possessing a working knowledge of all other departmental hotel operations. Proven track record of organizational skills, forward thinking, excellent time management and the ability to plan and direct the daily operations of a busy department. Minimum two years' previous experience at a front desk or concierge is preferred.

Spa Manager

Food and Beverage Servers

Executive Chef

The Executive Chef will be responsible for directing and training of culinary staff and all other kitchen workers. This position demands creativity and the ability to maintain the highest of culinary standards.

Responsibility for purchasing food; menu development, maintaining approved food cost, controlling labour costs, budgeting, managing all aspects of daily kitchen operations, including personnel and quality of preparation/production in our kitchens in accordance with The Reefs' standards. Expedite in kitchen as required. Ensure quality preparation and presentation, with the ability to assist on the line when needed. Must be familiar with current culinary trends and innovations, health regulations, training, and employee development. Actively participate in the marketing of the F&B outlets. Ensure that all kitchen safety and sanitation standards are consistently maintained. Ensuring SOP's are updated and created as needed to ensure the smooth running of all food and beverage outlets. Assume Manager on Duty role when needed. Applicants must have: extensive culinary background managing back of house in a hotel or restaurant, demonstrated ability to effectively interact with diverse cultural staff, proven track record in food cost and labour cost controls, ability to produce and maintain departmental budgets, minimum of at least 5 years' experience in a similar management position and has previously held a similar position in a 4 Diamond property. Executive Sous Chef

They must have knowledge of sanitation practices, quality control, recipe interpretation and prep duties and handle the more complex cooking assignments to ensure a high quality product. Pastry Chefs
